

Dress Code

Over the past years, we have highlighted in the bulletin what we would like our parishioners to wear when they come for worship. We want to promote what you can wear instead of what is not permitted. These guidelines were decided upon by the PPC in 2005.

The Catechism of the Church instructs us about our disposition and the manner with which we come as a community and as individuals to thank Our Father for His love for us.

We know there has been some unhappiness in certain quarters concerning the enforcement and we completely understand. There seemed to be varying standards. These have been looked into

After over a month of feedback and consultation with parishioners again, we believe that we can do better - in setting more specific guidelines concerning the dress code for men, ladies and children so that it will be less confusing.

Here are our guidelines:

For Men:

Shirts, polo or round-neck tee-shirts with sleeves - short or long.

Full length pants

Footwear - shoes or boots or sandals

For Ladies:

Tops with Sleeves.

Pants should be full length. We will accept lengths of 1 or 2 inches above the ankle.

Skirts, dresses 1 or 2 inches above the knees will be accepted.

Footwear – shoes, sandals, proper dress slippers

Children:

For all children above the age of seven the same dress code as the adults will apply.

For children under the age of seven

Boys: Shorts with lengths 1 or 2 inches above the knees

They must also use shoes or sandals.

Girls: shorts or skirts or dresses with lengths 1 or 2 inches above the knees.

Strictly Prohibited:

Clothing promoting vices like drugs, alcohol, violence.

Clothing made of spandex (skin-tight) and translucent (see-through) materials.

Clothing exposing entire shoulder, chest, back or thighs.

Sport Wear.

Flip Flops.
